DFES Bushfire Reminder: Building Protection Zones We all have a responsibility to reduce the risk of bushfire. By preparing your home or business, you increase the

chance that it will survive a

bushfire.

One way you can help protect your property is to create a circle of safety (building protection zone) around the building.

DFES has the following tips when creating a circle of safety:

- Create a 20 metre circle of safety around your home and other buildings by clearing all rubbish, long dry grass, bark and material that may catch fire.
- Prune lower branches (up to two metres off the ground) to stop a ground fire spreading into the canopy of the trees.
- Clear vegetation along the boundary of your property to create a firebreak. Make sure you meet your local government's firebreak requirements.
- Cut long grass and dense scrub.

Recycling Bin Collection (2020/2021 Waste Calendar Amendment)

In the waste collection calendar that was sent out to Katanning ratepayers recently, there was a print error on the Recycling and Waste Composting Bins Collection Map page.

Recycling bins (yellow topped) are collected fortnightly and not weekly.

Firewood Collection from **Reserves Prohibited**

The Shire of Katanning have received reports of illegal firewood collection from reserves in the area. Whilst the vast majority of people do the right thing, it's important to remind the public that collection of firewood from reserves is prohibited, patrols are being done in the area and those found taking firewood could receive a heavy penalty.

Additionally, the illegal collection of firewood from our reserves impacts on native wildlife and birds as it destroys natural habitat. Anyone requiring further information regarding this matter are encouraged to contact the Department of Parks and Wildlife Services on 9219 9000.
