As most of you remember, just over a year ago on Friday 7 February 2020, Katanning faced a large bushfire that has now become a part of the town's history.

The fire had started about 11.25am on the South West corner of the Woodanilling Shire and quickly escalated to a Level Two fire, spreading into the Katanning Shire. By Saturday, it was upgraded to Level Three and the fire was out of control and headed towards town.

There were over 300 volunteer firefighters on the fire ground throughout the week, including all of the surrounding districts to Katanning and Woodanilling, and many of our locals continued the clean up afterward, ensuring safety for all. These local hero's, together with the support from DFES, Water Bombers and many of our neighbours, saved our town.

Katanning continuously showcases that we are a cohesive community, whether it's supporting each other through the bad times or getting together and celebrating the good.

There is no better way to celebrate our town's diversity than at the annual Katanning Harmony Festival on Friday 12 and Saturday 13 March which will look a little different this year to align with COVID-19 restrictions but still set to be a memorable weekend of
