#### **End of Restricted Burning** Period from 1 May 2022

The Shire of Katanning advise that Open Burning Season has commenced as of Sunday 1 May 2022.

Residents do not require a permit to burn but are reminded that it is your responsibility to ensure the fire is contained and controlled at all times.

Please check the current weather conditions prior to commencing any burn, and as a courtesy notify your neighbours.

#### **Chimney and Flue Fires**

Each winter, fire fighters attend many house fires due to ash, soot and combustion residue that has built up inside chimney flues.

This residue can ignite causing a fire. In most cases you will see flames shooting out of the top of the chimney or a loud roaring noise!

To make sure your chimneys are ready, the Department of Fire and Emergency Services recommend you:

• Check the fire place brickwork, chimney / flue to make sure it is clean.

- Don't burn green wood.
- Look at purchasing some additives you can put in your fire while its burning that can help reduce residue build up (check out the local hardware stores).
- If your fireplace chimney is brick, check that the surrounding brickwork has not cracked. This can reduce the chance of a fire creeping through the course in back walls.
- Ensure that your wood heaters are installed and maintained by a qualified operator.

House fires can cause extensive property loss and damage. Most of these are accidental and preventable.
