Katanning Early Childhood **Hub Lotterywest Funding**

Thank you to the Hon. Shelley Payne MLC who visited Katanning on Friday 22 July 2022, to present a \$536,344 Lotterywest Grant to Shire of Katanning Deputy President John Goodheart for the Katanning Early Childhood Hub project.

The presentation which was held at the Shire Administration and Civic Centre was attended by Shire of Katanning Councillors, Staff and members of the Katanning Community.

The Katanning Early Childhood Hub project will deliver a hub of three essential facilities including a Family Centre, Community & Child Health Offices and Child Care. The Hub will activate currently vacant land (in Bokarup Street, Katanning) and integrate community facilities that are a vital component of creating healthy communities, supporting social inclusion and enhancing the wellbeing of local residents.

Architectural plans for the project are currently being developed with the construction phase of the project expected to begin in early 2023. The project has also received funding from the Department of Primary Industries and Regional

Katanning.

Rental Accommodation

The Shire of Katanning has one 4x2 family home available for rent at 19 Kaatanup Loop Katanning. The house has been designated as Key Worker Accommodation.

Key Workers are employees in services that are essential to the community but who may not be able to access appropriate accommodation.

Employers providing essential services in the following areas will be given priority:

- Law & Order and Public Safety
- Health and Ancillary Services
- Education; particularly early childhood education

Rent will be set at the market rate.

Department of Fire and **Emergency Services Reminder: The Australian** Fire Danger Rating System

The Australian Fire Danger Rating System (AFDRS) will go live on 1 September 2022.

The new system uses current science that significantly improves the ability to predict fire behaviour and reflects findings from extensive social research recommending a simplified, nationally

consistent system.

The new Fire Danger Ratings have four levels (instead of six) - Moderate, High, Extreme and Catastrophic.

There'll be actions for each level, so you'll know what to do to protect your life, family and property.

Self-Supporting Loan -Katanning Country Club

Council agreed to provide the Katanning Country Club Inc. with a self-supporting loan facility of \$250,000 at an estimated rate of 3.7% over a term of ten (10) years, for the Katanning Country Club Redevelopment Project subject to conditions outlined in the agenda.
