Community Grants Program 2022-2023 Closes 30 November

The Shire of Katanning Community Grants Program (CGP) provides funding support towards projects that promote community capacity, improve social participation and inclusion as well as enhance community harmony and social cohesion.

There are three CGP categories that are available to community organisations:

- Minor community grant under \$5,000 (ex GST)
- Major community grant over \$5,000 (ex GST)
- Triennium community grant (Minor and Major available)

Each application will be assessed against the following criteria:

- a) Does the project:
 - Meet a community need?
 - Benefit a sufficiently broad, or diverse, target group?
 - Align with the Shire of Katanning community vision?
- b) Does the organisation have the capacity to undertake and manage the project?
- c) Does the application represent value for money?

Collaborative community wide projects are encouraged.

To submit an application for CGP funding, applicants must

complete an application form located on the Shire of Katanning website at www.katanning.wa.gov.au/ community-grants.aspx or at the Shire of Katanning Administration building.

Please read the guidelines located on the website prior to submitting an application.

Applications are to be received by Wednesday 30 November 2022.
