Recognition of Long Serving Employees

Policy No:	5.5	
Policy Subject:	Recognition of Long Serving Employees	
Objectives:	To show appreciation to employees for extended periods of service and to promote good staff/Council relations.	
Policy Statement:	Council may recognise the contribution of long term employees with 20 years or more continuous service by presentation of a certificate at a Council reception.	
Guidelines:	An appropriate framed certificate will be presented on the completion of 20 years' service, along with an appropriate gift.	
	The employee and their partner are to be invited for drinks and a light supper at which the presentation will be made.	
	Where possible the Chief Executive Officer will arrange a combined function where several employees achieve long serving anniversaries within three months of each other.	
	At the discretion of the Chief Executive Officer, the employee shall be given the opportunity to nominate up to six family members or friends to be invited to the presentation.
