#### **GREEN WASTE COLLECTION**

The Shire of Katanning will offer a free Green Waste verge collection commencing Monday 4 November 2019.

Please make sure waste is on the verge before 6.00am Monday 4 November 2019.

To help prevent unsightly verges, you are encouraged to put your garden waste out the weekend of the 2 November 2019. Do not obstruct the footpath or your normal bin services and ensure waste does not obstruct line of sight of pedestrians or cars.

Residents are reminded that this is a Green Waste collection only. Contaminated garden waste

will not be removed.

Lawn clippings, cuttings and leaves must be in boxes or bags. To prevent damage, do not obstruct Telstra pits, water meters or power domes with green waste as mechanical equipment may be used. Please trim tree branches and pruning's to a max of 1.5m (5ft) and place bundles in line with kerb.



#### KIDSPORT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

#### **Apply online**

Eligible children in Western Australia can receive up to \$150 per calendar year to cover the costs of joining any approved KidSport club. Please ensure you apply early before your club's registration day so that you have your code ready as your application can take up to 10 business days to be assessed days.

#### **Eligibility**

To be eligible for KidSport applicants must be:

- 1. Aged 5 to 18 years
- 2. A resident in Western Australia
- 3. Named on a valid Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card
- 4. Registering with a KidSport approved club. Find a KidSport club.




