

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

At the February Ordinary Council Meeting for the Shire of Katanning, held on Tuesday 25 February, the following items were approved:

Katanning Artisan Collective

Council accepted the proposal from the Katanning Artisan Collective to relocate to the Town Hall building portion that was formerly occupied by the Visitor Centre and Council Chambers for a trial period of 12 months to be negotiated with the Chief Executive Officer.

Senior Employees

Council designated the following positions as senior employees under section 5.37 of the Local Government Act 1995: 1. Executive Manager Corporate and Community 2. Executive Manager Infrastructure and Assets

Council accepted the recommendation from the tender evaluation panel to accept the tender from A Laurino & Co in response to RFT 01-2020 Upgrade of the Katanning Country Club.

Restricted Burning Period

The Restricted Burning Period commenced 29 February 2020 for the Shire of Katanning and will be in place until the 30 April 2020 All burning during this time, including burning of garden refuse requires a 'Permit to Burn' from your local Bushfire Control Officer.

All conditions highlighted on a Permit must be adhered to, if conditions are not met an infringement may be issued under the Bushfires Act.
