Katanning Roller Flour Mill Expressions of Interest

Expressions of Interest are open until the 13th August 2007 with information packages and the EOI form available by contacting the Manager of Community Services Carl Beck on 98214200.

Conditions placed on any possible sale of the building will include.

1. The purchaser is to enter into a Heritage Agreement with the Heritage Council of Western Australia (HCWA) for the building within 3 months of the purchase of the building.
2. The purchaser agrees to expend a minimum of \$200,000 (including in-kind contributions/labour) within 3 years of purchasing the building.

The possible sale of the Katanning Roller Flour Mill is continuing to generate a lot of interest with a large number of possible private investors collecting the produced information package and looking at the options for conserving the building and turning it into an asset for the community.

Fruit Fly

The 2007/08 Fruit Fly Program has been a resounding success with no reports of fruit fly infestations. Monitoring traps are still strategically placed throughout the town, however with the onset of cooler weather outbreaks are not anticipated.

Truck Route

The Katanning/Dumbleyung truck route is complete from Henry St to the Great Southern Highway. As part of this bypass road the

Carew Street/Forrest Hill Rd intersection has been modified to form a Tee junction, improving visibility and safety to motorists. It is anticipated with the completion of the Katanning/Dumbleyung truck route the passage of heavy vehicles through the residential and central business districts of Katanning will be significantly reduced.

Realignment of Austral Tce Round-About

To comply with recommended safety standards the wall surrounding the round-about has been removed, semi mountable kerbing installed and all intersecting roads asphalted. This has resulted in a wider apron on the round-about and increased corner sweeps on Austral Tce and Clive St improving motorist safety.

Seniors Physical Activity Officer

The Shire has secured \$38,000 over two years from the Premiers Physical Activity Taskforce to employ a Seniors Physical Activity Officer two days per week at the Katanning Leisure Centre.

As a condition of the grant we are running a Seniors Physical Activity survey to determine the current levels of physical activity within the seniors community, what barriers there are to them becoming more physically active and what types of new activities could be implemented to encourage greater levels of physical activity. Survey forms are available at the Shire Office, Library and Leisure Centre and by down load from the Shires Website.
